COURSE GOALS: WE WILL GO THROUGH THE BASIC PROGRAMMING CONCEPTS SUCH AS VARIABLES, FUNCTIONS, IF STATEMENTS, CONDITIONS, AND BASIC DEBUGGING ETC. IN THE CONTEXT OF CREATING A SIMPLE MAPPING APPLICATION WITH THE ESRI JAVASCRIPT API. STUDENTS WILL HAVE A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF HOW TO START, HOW TO NAVIGATE THE ESRI JAVASCRIPT SITE, AND WILL BE ABLE TO TAKE A SIMPLE APPLICATION HOME WITH THEM TO CONTINUE DEVELOPING.

MATERIALS: A JAVASCRIPT REFERENCE MANUAL WILL BE PROVIDED FOR EACH STUDENT
